Europeans have a more polarized salary standard, either they are paid the highest amount or earn the lowest. Canadians have the highest base pay but have more average players than standout stars

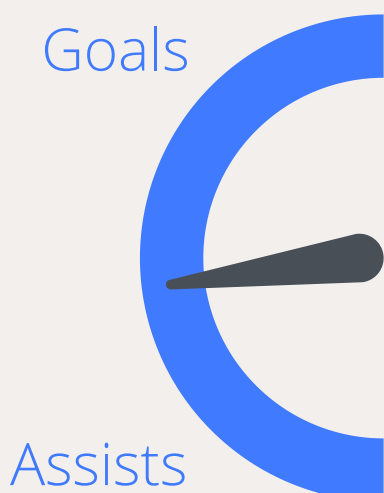
